

## Hythe and Dibden Neighbourhood Plan

### Summary of Regulation 16 consultation process

A joint consultation as set out within Regulation 16 of the Neighbourhood Planning (general) Regulations 2012 was undertaken by New Forest District Council and New Forest National Park Authority between 18<sup>th</sup> March and 29<sup>th</sup> April 2019. The councils jointly made press releases to local media outlets and directly emailed the statutory bodies listed in Table 2 below.

The draft Hythe and Dibden Neighbourhood Plan, Consultation Statement, Basic Conditions Statement and other supporting information was available online to view by members of the public as per the requirements set out within Regulation 15 Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012. Paper copies and representation forms were made available at 2 locations in Hythe – Hythe and Dibden Parish Council Office and the Community Centre and additionally at the New Forest District Council Offices in Lyndhurst and New Forest National Park Authority offices in Lymington. Representations were received by post or email to New Forest District Council (see Table 1 below).

Southampton City Council	Supports aims and objectives within the draft plan  Supports improved connections between Hythe and Dibden and Southampton. Concern regarding deliverability of further train or tram infrastructure.  SCC have started looking at the possibility of developing a mass transit system, i.e. a conglomeration of rail, bus rapid, high quality bus, demand responsive bus and physical infrastructure, to be delivered via the emerging Southampton Public Transport Strategy, and suggest that this may be something that the parish should consider whilst taking the neighbourhood plan forward.
