

391/03 AFC Fawley – request for the use of Clayfields Sports Centre

Consideration was given to a request from AFC Fawley to allow them exclusive use of the football facilities and preferential use of the other facilities at Clayfields Sports Centre.

Clayfields Sports Centre was built to provide recreational facilities for the community and to accept this request would mean that the needs of the current users could not be met.

RESOLVED

That the request from AFC Fawley for the use of Clayfields Sports Centre be refused.

392/03 Parish Hall – Hirers Liability Insurance – Minute 269/03 (b)

At the meeting of the Amenities Committee on 13 October 2003 it was agreed to make enquiries with Zurich Municipal about whether this Council would be able to offer Public Liability Insurance Cover to occasional hirers of the Parish Hall.

Zurich Municipal are able to provide this cover and it will cost an additional 10% of the hire fee. Hirers who produce evidence of their own insurance cover will not need to pay the additional 10%.

RESOLVED

- 1) That Hirer's Public Liability Insurance be provided for occasional hirers of the Parish Hall through Zurich Municipal.
- 2) That a 10% levy be put on the hire fee to cover the cost of the Insurance.
- 3) That the payment of a deposit premium of £100 + IPT be made to Zurich Municipal for the provision of Hirer's Public Liability Insurance.

393/03 Dibden Purlieu Improvement Scheme

Consideration was given to the provision of bus shelters within the Dibden Purlieu Improvement Scheme. The shelter was withdrawn from the original plan but requests have been received from residents to review that policy as it is felt a shelter is needed on each side of the road.

RESOLVED

1. That a scheme for provision of bus shelters is produced in association with the District Council.
2. That the views on the location of current bus stops be sought from bus users and the bus companies.
3. That an update on the Improvement Scheme is requested together with probable completion dates.

394/03 The Garth – Public Open Space

Members noted that the developers of The Garth site had withdrawn a request for this Council to maintain a small piece of land on the development.

395/03 Replacement of Fencing – Pennine Gardens

Consideration was given to a request from a resident of Pennine Gardens to replace a section of fencing adjacent to his property. The fencing was originally installed to protect the new shrubbery and was not intended to be permanent.

RESOLVED

That the request to replace the temporary fencing in Pennine Gardens be refused.

396/03 **Shrub Clearance - Challenger Way**

Consideration was given to a proposal from Orchard School to remove some shrubs owned by the Parish Council which are causing visibility problems for parents, children and road users on Challenger Way.

Whilst Members agreed with the need to improve sightlines in the area, concern was expressed that removing the shrubs would create a further hazard with access to the stream being too easy.

RESOLVED

That the Maintenance and Facilities Supervisor and Mr Short revisit the problem and bring forward alternative schemes to a future meeting of the Committee.

397/03 **Provision of Dog Waste Bin**

Consideration was given to the provision of a dog waste bin at the lake in Oakenbrow.

RESOLVED

That a dog waste bin be provided at a cost of £220.00.

398/03 **New Forest District Council Play Strategy Panel**

Members noted that the Maintenance and Facilities Supervisor is a member of the New Forest District Council Play Strategy Panel and is working with NFDC on co-ordinating the strategy for children's play for 2004-7.

399/03 **Young Sportsperson of the Year Award**

Consideration was given to the continuation of the Young Sportsperson of the Year Award due to the low number of applications received in recent years.

If it was decided to continue with the award, the appointment of a Working Party to consider nominations was also discussed.

RESOLVED

1. That the award will only be made if there are 3 or more nominations and this is made clear in all advertising.
2. That the existing Working Party of Mr Parkes, Mrs McLean and Mr Harrison be reappointed to consider nominations for the Young Sportsperson of the Year Award.
