Item 7 Community Safety Update

As the Chairman announced at the last Council meeting, negotiations with Hampshire County Council has resulted in the cost of service being reduced by £10,000 per annum for 2009/10 onwards.

Since the last report the service continues to target hot spots. During the quarter ending 31 December 2008 there were 99 calls to the dedicated community safety line and a further 45 calls to the 101 number. Over the same period the ACSO's disposed of 5 litres of wines and spirits and 14 cans of larger/beer from under aged drinkers, in addition 19 yellow cards were issued.

The Police Safer Neighbourhood Team produce a monthly newsletter which is published on our website and on the main noticeboards.
