## Child sexual exploitation Advice

### Advice for Parents:

- Be alert to changes in behaviour or signs of physical abuse such as bruising – speak to one of the support agencies available.
- Be aware of any new possessions they are bringing home that they wouldn't necessarily have the money for themselves.
- Monitor episodes of staying out late or not returning home.
- Understand the risks your child faces being online and take the necessary safeguarding measures.
- Talk openly to your child and more importantly listen to them.
- Don't judge your child for what they might have done, instead support them and together seek help and advice.
- Encourage your child to access the internet on laptops, tablets and phones in family rooms rather than privately in the bedroom. You are more likely to pick up on problems.

### Signs of CSE:

- Child goes missing for periods of time or frequently returns home late.
- Missing school.
- Returns home with new possessions they are unlikely to have had money for themselves.
- Mixing with older boys and girls.
- Apparent drug and/or alcohol use.
- Over-sexualised behaviour.
- Secretive behaviour especially around computers and phones.
