12. Consideration of Councillor C Harrison's motion to New Forest District Council.

"That, from 1 January 2007, the £80 car parking clock be abolished in all Hythe car parks and that all day parking be permitted in these car parks from this date with the display of an £8 car parking clock, to alleviate –

- (1) the traffic congestion arising from all day on-street parking in areas of Hythe because motorists are unwilling to pay for an £80 parking clock;

and

- (2) the resultant traffic chaos which has become particularly bad in the areas of West Street, the entrance to Hythe Marina, Jones Lane and Atheling Road since the introduction of the £80 charge, despite the fact that there are empty spaces in the adjacent car parks."
