Hampshire School Exam Results

The information that HCC has at the moment is very much provisional as individual schools may ask for re-marks on some individual results or in some cases larger groups. On the aggregate data for the County HCC currently have data for 66 of the 70 schools and academies. These results are showing that 63% of students across Hampshire have secured 5A*-C including English and mathematics compared to 60% last year. The national average was 57% last year and the press are reporting a decline in results nationally this year. If that proves to be the case, the schools within Hampshire will have performed very strongly.

However, as you will be aware, the Government have removed the 5A*-C including English and mathematics indicator from the national data set so HCC will not formally have a national average on this measure this year. Instead the government is focusing on a new measures called attainment 8 (and subsequently a measure called progress 8). At this stage HCC have the Hampshire data for these measures but we have no comparison points until the national results are published later this year.
