2.0 NOTES OF LAST MEETING

Notes of the last meeting held on the 12th December, 2016 were agreed as correct. It was agreed to modify the times of the consultation events to 1400 – 1900.

3.0 ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE CONSULTATION DAYS

It was agreed:

1. A3 size maps be prepared for the following areas:

- a. Hythe Village
- b. Dibden Purlieu
- c. Dibden
- d. Buttsash
- e. South of Hythe
- f. North of Hythe
- g. 1 large map

2. Each map to be vertical on a board with a table beside for people to write their comments

3. A second map to be prepared with colour and number coding and written explanations of the issues that the group has become aware of

It was highlighted that people can raise new ideas but the reason for the event is to check on the results from the first survey and the work of the Neighbourhood Planning Group

4. Group leads to develop the questions they wish to ask people and these will be agreed at the meeting on 16 January. The questions can then be added to the questionnaire that will be used by people manning the consultation event.

5. A separate map to be prepared of the St Johns Street car park area and PC Builders site showing an outline of the Churchill development proposals and questions to be asked of people whether they understand that the whole car park is to be sold and whether they foresee any parking issues as a consequence.
